Level 4 Small Team State Championships

Congratulations to all athletes who will be competing at the Level 4 Small Team State Championships! We are honored to be the first host of a small-team state meet. The teams coming to this meet have between 2 and 13 athletes. 3 scores will count toward the team scores for each session, and for overall team.

Dividing the Level 4 state meet into two meets is new for Colorado. Teams have been divided into two meets based on the number of athletes they have competing at each level. For Level 4, teams with 12 or fewer team members are competing in the Small Team meet at Airborne.

There will be 4 sessions, divided by best all-around score of the season. Each session will be divided into four equal age groups for awards. Achievement awards will not be given on each event, but every athlete will get a placement medal for each event and all-around.
